AMADEA broke a step slow, cruised up around the first turn, hooked inside foe leaving the half mile marker, vied with that one into the far turn, shook free leaving the quarter pole, under strong handling held off outside closer for the victory. VERI COLLECTED broke very slow, circled five deep from the quarter pole, in striking distance leaving the furlong marker, loomed a dangerous threat inside the sixteenth post, hung through the final jumps. CLOSE UP under strong handling ranged up three wide nearing the three eighths marker, roused on between rivals into the lane, evened out through the final stages, held on for the show. ITZA KITTY raced well off the pace and off the rail into the far turn, ducked inside nearing the sixteenth post, improved placing through the wire. SHESSWEETLIKECANDY broke sharp, keen refused to rate ran up on heels into the first turn, found a clean lane inside and chased from the quarter pole, faded through the stretch. RUNAWAY KITTEN away in good order inside, chased off the pace five wide into the second bend, came up empty. DICE ARM broke alertly, set the fractions for the opening half mile, caught mid-way down the backside, steadily weakened to the wire. GOTTA BE KIDDIN broke sharp, vied inside to the far turn, gave way from the quarter pole.
