CARIBBEAN PLEASURE broke sharp, vied inside around the turn, shook free from rival leaving the furlong marker, held a safe margin driving through the wire. OPTIMISTIC NATE sandwiched back at the start, advanced off the rail around the turn, four wide and running on the wrong lead, rallied late for the place. SONG RUNNER hard bump at the start, chased inside into the turn, angled out took aim three wide into the lane, chased on willingly for the show. TIZAFASTBULLET bumped forced out at the start, picked up momentum leaving the quarter pole, steadied in traffic towards the rear of the field nearing the furlong marker, tipped out improved late. GOLD FIBER lunged out bumped foe start, chased off the pace four wide, angled inside upper, had no late kick. SECESSION broke sharp, pressed two wide around the turn, gave way through the lane. TENAX slow into stride, never factored.
