SPURS UP raced off the vying three sum into the far turn, quickened stride leaving the quarter pole, four deep into the lane, wore down inside rival under an all out rally up in time. THANK YA PETE bumped foe at the start, quickly recovered vied inside into the far turn, shook free for a brief moment into the lane, running on the wrong lead, dug in gamely denied at the wire. GRAND PARK VIEW saved ground off the pace into the far turn, cut the corner into the lane, finished willingly inside rivals for the show money. BERMUDA RUN tracked the pace around the first turn, put to task five wide leaving the three eighths post, between runners late, evened out to the wire. BEJUCO very slow into stride, trailer leaving the quarter pole, quickened stride bid between foes into the lane, full of momentum stymied in traffic in upper stretch, improved placing through the final stages. PLEASENTHANKU hustled up around the first turn, vied three wide battling into the second bend, weakened through the lane. COLD AS HELL broke sharp, chased the leader two wide around the first turn, under pressure vied between rivals into the far turn, gave way through the stretch. GABRIEL'S WING bumped back at the start, saved ground well off the pace, never threatened.
