CEDAR'S WISH broke sharp, set a pressured pace along the rail around the turn, fended off two challengers leaving the sixteenth marker, finished gamely to the wire. EMBERLY raced off the pace into the turn, circled the field five deep leaving the quarter pole, engaged the leaders from the outside nearing the sixteenth marker, unable to sustain momentum through the final stages hung at the wire. CRUZ IN THE CASTLE chased from off the pace and off the rail, put to task four wide and between runners turning for home, racing on the wrong lead and between runners, finally swapped over to the proper lead and finished willingly through the wire. COACH RUBE off to a slow start, saved ground from off the pace leaving the quarter pole, darted out into the lane, four deep improved her placing through the final yards. LET'S DO THIS raced off the pace and inside into the turn, quickened the tempo to bid along the rail leaving the furlong marker, evened out through the final sixteenth. AT THE HALF lacked speed away from the gate, off the pace and inside pressed on around the bend, flattened out to the wire. MACHEN REIGNS very slow to stride, raced off the pace four wide then five wide, very erratic into the bend, drifted out, came up empty. TIZ THE REASON sent to vie inside around the turn, under pressure between runners in upper stretch, gave way. WITNESS THE ENERGY sent hard vied out side around the turn, between runners turning for home, gave way to the wire.
