BIG SMILE off to beautiful start, able to settle into a comfortable rhythm leaving the first turn, controlled the tempo around the far turn, never challenged leaving the sixteenth pole, kicked away late driving. GHOSTLYPRINCE raced off the pace leaving the first turn, quickened between runners heading into the second bend, rail bid leaving the sixteenth, dove under the line to snag the place at the wire. RAGING BEAR stalked the leader leaving the first turn, two wide leaving the quarter, put to task into the lane chased the leader, conceded the place under the wire.
