MAGIC MOVER stalked the leader two wide under restraint into the club house turn, given the queue sprinted away from inside rival nearing the three eights marker, unchallenged turning into the lane, held a safe margin driving through the wire. KATMANDU tracked off the top pair inside down the backside, inside pursuit from the furlong marker, chased on late, bested the rest. DIRECT APPEAL raced off the pace inside into the final turn, angled out three wide into the lane, finished willingly for the show. BIG JOE B saved ground well off the pace into the far turn, roused on four deep leaving the quarter pole, evened out through the final sixteenth. FORTUNATE SON chased the leader three wide down the back stretch, weakened through the lane. BAD LINEAGE raced off the pace three and four wide, never threatened. HOPE'S ALIVE hustled up out of the gate, set the pace around the club house turn, collared leaving the half mile marker, gave way, eased home.
