GABRIEL'S WING stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, ranged up outside the leader turning for home, battled under an all out drive, won the photo in the final jump. ADVANCE CASH vied outside leaving the first turn, kicked away from inside rival nearing the furlong marker, under a drive and inside rivals through the final sixteenth chased on valiantly denied only by the photo. NOTION TO TAPIT raced off the pace and along the inside, quickened and shifted out four wide into the lane, widest leaving the sixteenth pole, found best strides late closed willingly through the wire. KENNY HAD A NOTION stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out to bid three wide turning for home, chased on evenly through the final sixteenth. READYSEEKGO vied inside around the first turn and then down the backside, under pressure leaving the furlong marker, faded inside through the final yards. VESELSKY very slow around the first turn, rail move leaving the quarter pole, came up empty. JACKED slow into stride, saved ground far turn, never threatened. QUALIFLY raced off the pace and four wide, lost contact leaving the quarter pole, weakened. SHANGHAI WARRIOR chased the pace three wide into far turn, gave

way.
