JULITA BONITA settled into stride off the pace and off the rail down the backside, put to task inside leaving the quarter pole, angled out three wide into the lane, running on the wrong lead rallied late, nailed inside rival at the wire. ADDITIONAL FACTOR broke sharp, set the pace along the rail into the far turn, clear leaving the furlong marker, battled inside through the final stages, game try nipped at the wire. LOLITA broke alertly, chased the leader two wide throughout, bid four wide into the lane, finished willingly held clear for the show. AMAMA saved ground well off the pace down the backside, clean rail trip through the lane, evened out through the final sixteenth. CREATIVE CATCH stumbled at the start, trailer off the rail down the backside, had no late response. SAICHI'S GIRL away in good order, saved ground mid-pack into the far turn, under pressure from the quarter pole, came up empty. SPICY YEARS very slow into stride, roused on off the pace between runners into the far turn, had no late impact. RIGHT RIDE stumbled at the start, saved ground well off the pace down the back stretch, never threatened.
