DOCTOR PARDO raced off the pace and off the inside into the far turn, shifted out four deep nearing the furlong marker, widest in the three-way fight leaving the sixteenth pole, dug in determinedly, kicked away under the wire. STRIVE FOR STRIDE tracked between and just off the top flight into the far turn, rail bid leaving the furlong marker, battled inside through the final sixteenth, gave in grudgingly late. BORLETTI (IRE) pressed the pace three deep leaving the first turn, bid same three wide position leaving the quarter pole, outside but inside fading front runner poked a head Infront turning into the lane, battled between runners through the final sixteenth, out finished settled third. SCREW LOOSE quick start, sprinted to a clear lead leaving the first turn, set a taxing solo pace into the second bend, drifted out into the lane, faded wide through the final sixteenth. EYES ELEVEN very slow into stride, towards the rear leaving the quarter pole, improved placing along the rail through the wire, no real threat. GHOSTLYPRINCE slow start, four wide journey down the backside and around the far turn, never fired through the stretch. RAGING BEAR chased the pace two deep into the far turn, roused on leaving the quarter pole, weakened through the stretch. TOBI WAN KENOBI slow into stride, saved ground far turn, never factored. HERE COMES RUSTY tracked the pace inside to far turn, gave way.
