ROCK OF AGES broke sharp, set a pressured pace along the rail down the backside, repelled inside challenger leaving the quarter pole, shook off stubborn outside rival into the lane, held sway driving. MAGICAL SURPRISE broke alertly, prompted the pace two wide into the far turn, three wide pursuit into the lane, chased on well late, bested the rest. BOLD ROCK saved ground down the backside, tested the leader along the rail approaching the quarter pole, no match from the furlong marker, stayed on willingly for the show. FIBER PROOF rated around the first turn, sent between runners leaving the five sixteenth marker, evened out through the lane. NOT MY CIRCUS shuffled back soon after the start, middle move four deep into the far turn, bid stalled out through the final sixteenth. ARIE FERRARI saved ground off the pace, pressed along the rail around the second bend, weakened through the stretch. BUSTER THE BULLY chased the pace three wide around the first turn, under pressure nearing the quarter pole, faltered through the stretch.
