FOX FIFTY EIGHT rated well off the pace down the back stretch, weaved in and out of traffic leaving the quarter pole, never broke stride slipped inside in upper stretch, rallied clear for the victory. RIO OSO broke alertly, prompted the pace along the rail around the first turn, sent to the attack inside leaving the quarter pole, stuck a head in front turning into the lane, no match from the sixteenth marker, chased on late. SPERRY CHALET away in good order, roused on three wide down the backside, chased four deep from the furlong marker, stayed on willingly for the show. STARSHIP POLARIS raced well off the pace three wide into the far turn, six deep through the lane, improved position through the final stages. OUT OF MIND bumped at the start, raced off the pace four and five wide, had no late kick. JUDY G bumped at the start, advanced between runners down the backside, came up empty late. JUSTICE YOU SAY hustled up into the first turn, set the pace off the rail down the backside, collared upper, running on the wrong lead faded through the stretch. SPICEY TICEY broke alertly, saved ground mid-pack into the far turn, weakened through the stretch. TURKISH TEA urged along four and five wide to keep pace down the backside, gave way upper. MAYBE A BLOND shuffled back at the start, outrun down the back stretch, never factored.
