SAILOR SAM broke sharp, set a pressured pace along the rail into the far turn, repelled bids leaving the furlong marker, kicked away driving for the victory. HAMDOUN rated inside around the first turn, given the queue vied three wide into the far turn, rallied through the final sixteenth, bested the rest. MUSTWINAGENDA tracked the pace mid-pack four wide into the far turn, sent to the attack three wide leaving the furlong marker, closed in willingly in time for the show prize. SPEEDY SAMMY broke alertly, vied two wide leaving the first turn, pressed between rivals into the second bend, running on the wrong lead, evened out lost the show under the wire. KUKAI became very rank at the gate pre-start, loaded reluctantly, broke slow at the bell, raced well off the pace down the backside, had no late impact. MR GARET'S JOY saved ground well off the pace, rail bid around the far turn, weakened through the stretch. RIVERMONT DR very slow into stride, never threatened.
