A LITTLE BIT CRAZY settled off the rail the first turn, gave chase leaving the turn, raced in the three path on the far turn and came along to take third later yards. MAKINLIMMARGARITAS took the lead and angled to the inside to show the way, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, was met a the rail past the quarter pole then flattened in the lane. MISS ANTIETAM raced in the three path the first turn, picked up the chase nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn near the rail and ran evenly in the stretch. ONE LAS OLAS raced well back in the four path the first turn,

left the turn outside and gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn in the four and five paths and showed little in the lane.
