SPECIAL KAYLEE gave chase through the backstretch, raced in the four path on the turn and dug in the final furlong to take over the closing yards. BLUSHING BIP BOP became fractious behind the gate then ducked in and hit the stall door at the break, set a pressured pace inside, contested the edge at the rail on the turn, dug in under steady handling leaving the turn but was caught in the final yards. BIT OF BLESSINGS engaged in close chase and factored in the three path on the turn, but was outfinished in the duel through the stretch. CEDAR'S IMAGE gave chase outside, raced in the six path on the turn and finished well to close the gap. SWISS HORIZON gave chase inside, rounded the turn near the rail then flattened stride later yards. BOLD INDY chased, raced in the three path on the turn, eased outward leaving the turn and showed little in the lane. OUR BREW engaged in close early chase but faded in the three path on the turn. LOCKDOWN VANNA was taken to the outside while being kept in check and raced wide on the turn. Both Juniper Grace and Fantasy Frost were returned to the paddock for a late change of rider, but were eventually withdrawn.
