PENNY LOAFER rated off the pace down the backside, long slow methodical gain outside rivals around the far turn, captured FLAG OFFICER approaching the sixteenth marker, wore that rival down through the final stages, up in the final jump. FLAG OFFICER bumped shuffled of stride at the start, stalked the pace two wide around the club house turn, seized control of the lead into the far turn, hooked by PENNY LOAFER nearing the sixteenth marker, dug in gamely inside that one denied under the wire. TACTICS settled off the pace inside into the final turn, angled out four wide for the stretch drive, along willingly for the show. RAGTIME SCRIBBLE raced off the pace three and four wide, had no late impact. RETURN FIRE sent to the front around the first turn, set the pace along the rail into the back stretch, collared surrendered the lead into the far turn, under pressure faded through the stretch. TREE OF DEM saved ground off the pace, had no late response.
