FELICIAS CINCO relaxed well off the pace and off the rail into the far turn, given the queue five wide leaving the quarter pole, worked out six wide into the lane, sustained the rally through the final sixteenth, went clear under the wire. GURNEY HALLECK tracked the pace three wide down the back stretch, sent to the attack leaving the quarter pole, four deep on even terms outside GIMME A HOLLER leaving the furlong marker, battled hard to gain a very slim advantage nearing the sixteenth post, running on the wrong lead churned on through the final stages, conceded to outside closer, bested the rest. GIMME A HOLLER sent hard into the first turn, set an aggressive pace along the rail into the far turn, collared in upper stretch, fought on hard through the final stages, conceded grudgingly. SWIFT WATERS outrun down the backside, quickened stride leaving the quarter pole, angled out five wide into the lane, improved position late. MUSICAL STANDARD pressed the pace inside into the far turn, bid along the rail leaving the furlong marker, worked off the inside through the lane, evened out through the final stages. HELL OFA HILLBILLY bumped at the start, saved ground off the pace down the back stretch, had no late impact. MITOTE squeezed back at the start, urged along four wide down the backside, came up empty. MALIBU SON bumped at the start, chased the leader two wide into the far turn, gave way upper. BARSOOM under heavy pressure off the pace down the backside, faltered through the stretch.
