DUNCAN IDAHO clean start from outside post, dueled three wide into the turn, shook free from inside rivals leaving the furlong marker, under strong handling powered clear through the final sixteenth. YOUTHINKTHATSFUNNY bobbed at the break, settled off the pace into the turn, circled four wide approaching the furlong marker, chased on well to secure the place. HONEYQUIST quick start, dueled inside around the turn, under pressure through the final sixteenth, evened out through the final stages, held clear for the show money. PENGUIN POWER roused on off the dueling trio into the turn, chased inside leaving the quarter pole, bid flattened out through the lane. ROCKET APPEAL slow to stride out of the chute, roused on inside leaving the quarter pole, bid three wide into the lane, had no late punch. LITTLE ROO ROO broke a step slow, under urging through the chute, pressed four wide off the pace leaving the furlong marker, left lead came up empty late. JEFFERSON NATIVE broke sharp, dueled inside around the turn, under pressure leaving the furlong marker, faded through the final sixteenth.
