SLANDEROUS outrun around the first turn, came into view approaching the quarter pole, six deep circled the field from the furlong marker, rallied with good energy through the final sixteenth, drew clear. PARTY QUEEN raced well off the pace and off the rail, bid five wide from the furlong marker, worked very hard through the final sixteenth, chased on late nailed the place at the wire. SUZIES PRIDE urged on early to keep pace with the vying front runners, chased three wide into the lane, inside through deep stretch, finished willingly nipped for the place. HOPE SHE FIRES broke very sharp, vied two wide into the far turn, collared leaving the quarter pole, flattened out through the wire. CICATRIZ roused on early to keep pace with the swift pace, lost ground into the far turn, weakened through the stretch. SONG AND A BREEZE fractious in the gate, reloaded without the rider, broke alertly vied inside leaving the first turn, under pressure leaving the quarter pole, gave way through the lane. CITIFIED in tight along the rail around the first turn, pressed inside to the second bend, faltered through the stretch.
