NOTHING BUT HEIR broke step slow, rushed along through the traffic into the turn, found a clean lane three wide nearing the furlong marker, all out drive through the final sixteenth held on under the wire. IDIOSYNCRASIES raced off the pace into the turn, ducked inside for the stretch drive, bravely fought on along the rail, strong late rally just missed. CULMINATE chased the pace three wide around the turn, outside rivals through the final sixteenth, finished willingly for the show. GOLDEN ADAGE roused hard out of the chute, set a pressured pace along the rail around the turn, under pressure evened out through the final stages. POPS HARPER pressed on three wide to keep pace around the bend, bid flattened out through the final sixteenth. BOSSME saved ground off the pace, roused on into the lane, never fired late. STORE SALE slow into stride, never factored.
