I'M THE MONEY MAN raced out of the picture into the far turn, seen four wide nearing the quarter pole, steady progress picked off rivals one by one into the lane, with only two to catch, rallied outside rivals with good energy through the final sixteenth, went clear under the wire. BREAK THE CHAINS hustled up at the start, vied two wide into the far turn, went clear leaving the quarter pole, collared in deep stretch, chased on well to secure the place award. SOCIAL CHIC under urging soon after the start, in tight quarters forced through along the rail nearing the quarter pole, loomed a threat into the lane, no match from the sixteenth marker, stayed on willingly for the show. STORMIN ROCKET raced off the pace into the far turn, teed up three wide shuffled in traffic leaving the quarter pole, had no late punch. BOSS E BOOGS broke sharp, vied inside into the far turn, under pressure leaving the quarter pole, faded through the stretch. ROCKET APPEAL pressed the vying two sum three wide down the backside, gave way through the lane.
