NOTHING BUT HEIR away in good order, pressed the pace off the rail around the turn, drifted out under pressure leaving the furlong marker, five wide sustained rally nailed inside rival late. HEAD OF THE CLASS broke sharp, set a contested pace along the rail around the turn, battled on gamely inside rival through the final sixteenth, conceded under the wire. THE COMMISH saved ground off the top two around the turn, clean rail trip through the final furlong, chased on willingly for the show. LITTLE LUKEY raced off the pace around the turn, put to task four wide into the lane, running on the wrong lead had no late kick. MINELLA hustled up inside out of the chute, chased the top pair along the rail around the turn, faded through the stretch. STEAL THE CASH sluggish out of the chute, never threatened late. BLESSEDNOTLUCKY pressed on early to keep pace, under stress leaving the quarter pole, gave way through the lane.
