LUCKY BOP raced off the pace and just off the inside into the far turn, upped the tempo worked between runners nearing the furlong marker, found best strides along the rail through the final sixteenth, rallied with good energy for the victory. CLIMATE CHANGE broke sharp, set the fractions into the far turn, roused clear nearing the five sixteenth post, held the lead into deep stretch, collared late by inside closer chased on well to secure the place. COLLECTING ANGELS three wide pursuit from the quarter pole, no match nearing the sixteenth marker, finished evenly held on for the show. LOOK AHEAD rated around the first turn, forced the pace along the rail into the far turn, clean rail trip through the lane, bid flattened out missed out on the show. LAUGHINTOTHEBANK stumbled at the start, saved ground off the pace, never threatened. DIAKONISSA fractious in the gate, raced up close three wide around the first turn, steadily gave way from the quarter pole.
