RED DAWN COMING rated off the hot pace four wide into the far turn, quickened leaving the quarter pole, eighth deep inhaled the lead group turning for home, kicked away through the final sixteenth. JULITA BONITA rated off the pace and off the rail into the far turn, made steady progress leaving the quarter pole, full of momentum split foes nearing the sixteenth post, ducked inside late rallied for the place. SPICY YEARS broke sharp, vied between runners into the far turn, battled into the lane, conceded grudgingly through the final stages, safely in for the show. MY BROTHERS ANGEL tracked the pace four wide into the far turn, sent to the attack five wide into the lane, running on the wrong lead, evened out missed the show. NOT MY CIRCUS raced well off the pace three wide into the far turn, roused on four wide through the lane, went by the faders late. SEATHERNY accelerated quickly out of the gate, pressed the hot pace three wide into the far turn, faded very late. ROCK N'OPPORTUNITY saved ground off the pace, never threatened. FIBER ROCKS hopped at the start, quickly recovered set a hot contested pace along the rail into the far turn, under pressure leaving the quarter pole, gave way through the lane. THEY NOT LIKE US slow into stride, never factored. MR MAHOMES broke alertly, chased inside down the back stretch, urged on from the quarter pole, retreated through the lane.
