## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

IMPETUS ECHO (GB) trailer down the back stretch, weaved through traffic around the second bend, found a clean path three wide leaving the sixteenth post, running on the wrong lead, surged inside rival up in time. WAC IS FAST raced off the duel and off the rail down the backside, tipped out six wide for clear run through the stretch, strong rally from the sixteenth post, nailed by inside rival at the wire. TIDBIT tracked off the duel three wide, took aim four deep from the quarter pole, willingly up for the show under the wire. SONG AND A BREEZE broke sharp, dueled two wide around the first turn, shook off inside foe leaving the three eighths marker, battled inside into the lane, flattened out through the final stages. EMPIRE'S TREAT clipped heels soon after the start, chased inside off the topflight from the quarter pole, fade through the final sixteenth. TAPWRIT WARRIOR raced off the duel three wide, bid four wide from the furlong marker, had no late punch. TIA MAYIN raced off the duel mid-pack into the far turn, pressed four wide from the quarter pole, weakened through the stretch. TALAVERA slow into stride, raced off the pace and off the rail, never threatened. RITZ ON BROADWAY slow into stride, raced off the pace four wide around the second bend, never factored. HIS CHOICE frenzied duel inside around the first turn, steadily retreated through the lane.
