## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

ITSALLGOODMAN saved ground while being reserved early, moved up two-wide on the far turn, took command entering the stretch and drew off to win with something left. PUTTINGONTHEFOIL tracked THATSWHATIMHEREFOR, took the lead from that one nearing the half mile pole, responded when asked but was no match for ITSALLGOODMAN during the drive but proved to be second best. AUGUST RAIN was unhurried early, rallied four-wide into the stretch and finished well in a steady effort. PATRIOTIC FREEDOM bobbled at the start then was allowed to settle while racing two-wide, came three-wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. THATSWHATIMHEREFOR saved ground setting the pace to near the half mile pole and gave way readily when headed.
