KNOPFLER sat in striking range along the rail, found a seam inside at the quarter pole, and won driving. AMERICAN FARMER settled four to five wide, moved up quickly approaching the quarter pole to challenge the lead, and was outkicked. ALL RUN unhurried while three wide, and rallied mildly for show. PERDITION stalked the early pace while three wide, and lacked the rally that was required. OVERLY FAST bid belatedly. CURLIN ROCKS chased to no avail. QUINTO SOL stalked five wide in the backstretch, and wilted. STONE CARVER showed the way early, was challenged at the quarter pole but had no fight and gave way.
