MACHINA stalked four wide in the first turn, rallied between foes at the head of the stretch, and got the nod after a long, determined drive. TEXAS HUMOR stalked the early pacesetters while three wide, was under a snug hold in the backstretch, took over the lead at the quarter pole, battled on while showing signs of tiring late and lost the nod after a long drive. CROWN OF CAIRO was unhurried then settled five wide, moved up menacingly mid-stretch and was outfinished. SOLAR FORCE broke inward, trailed and lacked a kick. CHATTY GAL showed the way under a hold, and was collared into the stretch. RUNWAY LIGHTS stumbled leaving the gate, attended the pace from between foes, was unable to keep pace with the field in the final turn and stopped.
