PERDITION saved ground while being unhurried, rallied two-wide into the stretch and finished fast to be up in the final sixteenth to win going away. MENDELJOHN (IRE) was allowed to settle racing two-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. TENNESSEE MOSES dueled with STONE CARVER racing along the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the eighth pole but was unable to resist the top two late. IMPERIAL HORNET was bumped at the start by OUR PACT the saved ground racing in the back of the field and improved his position. OUR PACT broke in to bump IMPERIAL HORNET then was three-wide racing in the middle of the field, came five-wide into the stretch and was not a factor. STONE CARVER dueled with TENNESSEE MOSES for the lead from along the outside to the stretch and tired.
