PUTTINGONTHEFOIL took command early, responded to a looming threat from GHOSTLY SPITFIRE at the quarter pole and was kept to task. TITIAN trailed the field, was roused in the final turn, shifted out five wide mid-stretch and surged in the final yards getting up for second. GHOSTLY SPITFIRE stalked three wide in the first turn, went in pursuit of the leader nearing the quarter pole, was unable to reach the eventual winner and was bested late. QUARTERBACK DAK sat in striking distance along the rail, came under urging entering the stretch, shifted out four wide and closed gamely. NEWHART saved ground early then shifted out four wide in the backstretch, rallied four wide at the head of the lane, lacked the kick that was needed and steadied deep stretch in traffic. ACCIDENTAL GENIUS unhurried early, tracked outside from the five path, and lacked a closing response. TAYLOR FIELD lacked a bid.
