STREET VENDOR saved ground while showing the way, gained a good advantage into the final turn, was showing signs of tiring while drifting out and held safely. BODEMONSTER stalked the early pace under a snug hold, moved up closer leaving the backstretch, closed but was no match for the winner. POINT TO THE STARS sat midpack, closed gradually into the stretch and was up in time for show. TRAPEZE tracked four wide, moved to the rail, lodged an all out bid into the stretch and flattened late. ERLICH saved inside early, shifted three wide leaving the front side, tracked five wide, lodged a bid then evened out. AMEER offered little. GOOD BYE PUTIN was under a strong hold entering the opening turn, was five to six wide entering the front side, stalked the pace while four wide, and tired early. LONESOME CAT saved to no avail. *The 1 1/2m time was unavailable.
