CLEVER RACE vied for the lead from two wide around the first turn then tracked the leader down the backstretch and made a rebid on the final turn to take the lead near the three sixteenth pole and drew off. SELECTIVELY SWEET was forwardly placed from three wide down the backstretch then tipped in to two wide to make a late run to be second best. MISS ST. CLAIRE rushed to the lead into the first turn then drew clear going into the final turn but was collared near the three sixteenths and tired. WON BRIGHT LIGHT raced near the back down the backstretch then advanced from three to four wide to make a rally. REAL SILK stalked the pace from four wide down the backstretch then moved up from three wide on the final turn but failed to menace. GOOD BRIGHT FLAMES saved ground down the backstretch then then tipped out to two wide on the final turn and showed mild late interest to improve position. PATIENT EMILIE trailed the field to final turn and passed tiring rivals. CHIP SHORTAGE prompted the pace from the inside to the three furlong marker and faded. CHIEF EXPRESS raced wide and was not a threat. TIFF WITH JIMMY raced off the pace for a half and was done.
