THISONEISFORYOU broke sharply to go to a pressured lead to midway through the turn then edged away and drew off in the stretch to prove best. MISS ST. CLAIRE chased the leaders from the inside before tipping out to three wide in upper stretch to make a run but was no match for the winner and proved second best. TARKINGTON SUNRISE rushed up to press the pace from two wide to midway through the turn and tired. TAKEITTOTHEHOUSE hustled along to vied for the lead from between horses to the three furlong marker before shifting out to go three wide around the turn but was empty. REAL SILK raced in the middle of the pack while giving an even effort and was best of the rest. D'BUSKER race near the back while racing two wide around the turn and passed a tired one. NORMA JEAN BLING was void of speed and outrun. TOO SPICY raced off the pace early to the three furlong marker before retreating.
