SMOOCHIE BOO went to the front to set the pace while leading throughout, was engaged near the five sixteenth pole and fended off that rival and drew clear for the win. MOMMA MIA was forwardly place while racing three wide then tipped out four wide near the three furlong marker to engage the leader going into the turn but was no match for the winner and held on for the place. GATSBY'SGREENLIGHT was allowed to settle at or near the back to the final turn then made a four wide bid through the turn for the late rally and missed the place. SHEZADEVIL stalked the pace from three wide down the backstretch but lacked room near the quarter pole but kept on and was outfinished in the stretch. FOGGY MORNING raced four wide into the first turn then tracked the leaders from three wide and made a mild bid on the final turn but failed to sustain that bid. SERAPHINA SEA was unhurried around the first turn moved up slightly on the backstretch but was always back. SECURITY QUEEN saved ground to no avail.
