BIG WOODS rushed up to prompt the pace from two wide, moved up to engage the leader near the three furlong marker and dueled inside of RAY MEFASOLATEEDOE to the wire and won the nod. RAY MEFASOLATEEDOE roused to the front to set a clear pace to the three furlong marker before being headed and dueled inside of BIG WOODS to the wire and gave way grudgingly. LEE STREET settled in the middle of the pack around the first turn then moved between horses near the half mile marker, continued to move up from three wide on the final turn and was gaining late on the dueling leaders to be a clear third. ALOTLIKECHOCOLATE was forwardly placed on the inside but lacked a bid and proved best of the rest. ROBBIESSTORMANGEL was off a step slow and trailed the field around the first turn then moved up from four wide, tipped in to three wide on the final turn to make a mild rally. ALAJUELA was off a step slow and settled near the back to the final turn then made a rail bid to improve his position. LOUIE LE COEUR ran loose briefly prior to the race, then tracked the leaders from two wide to the final turn and faded. SAINTED was allowed to settle near the back and passed a tired one. MOONDOGGIE was fractious in the gate, raced four wide in to the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack down the backstretch before dropping back.
