OUR FAVORITE SON raced in the middle of the pack down the backstretch then advance around the turn to run down the leader and cleared late. TEXAS TOWN hustled to the front to take the early lead from three wide then drew clear on the turn but was collared late and was second best. SWEET LA CREMA was forwardly place, moved up from two wide on the turn, tipped out to four wide in upper stretch and was gaining late for the place. LAURI'S WISH raced near the back early then advanced from four wide on the turn but fell back entering the stretch and made a rebid for a late run to improve his position. PERFECT EDGE settled in the middle of the pack while saving ground before making a mild bid in the stretch but was outfinished late. BRAHMS BOY vied for the lead from the inside to the turn then fell back slightly but made a late bid into the stretch and faltered. OCEAN JACKPOT rushed up to press the pace from two wide to the three furlong marker then chased the leader through the turn and weakened. HI YAH raced near the back and pass a tired one. FLASHY LOVER showed no early speed, raced four wide on the turn but was not a threat. HALMSTAD raced close up on the pace early then stopped, bled and was transported on the equine ambulance.
