TONI'S INFERNO void of early speed, made a steady gain, rallied inside down the lane and got up in time. INCHHIGHATAHUNDRED raced within striking distance, came around the final turn on the outside, made a bid, took the lead down the lane and was caught late for the win. BEACH BLANKET pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, was outfinished by the top two, but proved best of others. TONTERIA raced in the middle of the field, moved up on the outside around the final turn, made a wide bid, but was no real factor. HEAVENLY DEAL void of early speed, came around the second turn on the outside, made a mild bid, but was no threat. JOSH G went to the front, drove clear, saved ground and faded. FLASH N CLASS raced evenly near the back and was never a threat. SOPHIE'S PAINTER pressed the early pace and made a steady retreat. FAST VERDICT always raced near the back and showed little. LOST DA VINCI raced within striking distance, dropped back and was outrun.
