CRUSIN LIKE A CAT vied for the early lead, saved ground, drove clear down the final stretch and finished well. APRIORITY CATCH challenged for the early advantage, forwardly placed throughout, proved no match for the winner late, but held on for place. MISS ROSIE broke out, raced within striking distance, made a wide bid and missed second. RADIANT REBEL brushed at the start, raced within contention and lacked a late kick. OLIVIA G raced within striking distance, came around the final turn on the outside, faded and was no threat late. BROADWAY PEARL always raced near the back and lacked a rally.
