BARBACOA raced near the middle of the field, moved up on the outside around the final turn, made a rally down the stretch and drove clear at the wire. INSIGNIS raced in the middle of the pack, saved ground around the final turn, made a late bid and was a clear second. UXMAL raced within striking distance, made a late bid, racing between horses, proved no match for the top two, but got up for show. CONFUCIUS lacked early speed, came around the second turn on the outside, made a wide gain and missed third. LO LO'S LAUGHTER raced within striking distance, weakened and lacked a finish. KINGSCOTE void of early speed and passed tired ones late. HIGH PRINCE unprepared start, trailed early, moved up and hung. VODKA MARTINI dueled for the early lead, saved ground and faded. SECULAR STAGNATION always raced near the back and showed little. BELLO CREEDO challenged for the early lead and was finished early.
