CATALINA EXPRESS vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, drove clear down the home stretch, was collared by SEVEN DIGITS, dueled to the wire and prevailed for the win. SEVEN DIGITS lacked early speed, had an outside, made a wide bid, dueled late and missed. SILVER SCREEN void of early speed, racing in the back, made a wide gain and closed well. U RASCAL U raced within striking distance, had a wide trip, made a mild bid, but was no factor. ELIGIO pressed the early pace, came around the final turn three wide and weakened down the home stretch. STANIEL CAY lacked early speed and was never a threat. GYPSY SQUALL raced within contention and was finished early. COME ON MULITCH dueled on the front end, dropped back and was outrun.
