DOUBLEBARRELVINNY vied for the early lead, saved ground around the turn, angled out down the lane, dueled between rivals and was just up. ON THE HORIZON pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout, dueled down the home stretch and just missed. HOLD THE DRAMA challenged on the front end, took the lead around the turn, drove clear and lacked a late kick. UNFORGETABLEIMELDA lacked early speed, moved up, but was no factor. AYE BAY BAY raced evenly near the back and was never a threat. ONE SWEET DEAL pressed the early pace, saved ground around the turn and faded. SPUN SILK lacked early speed, saved ground around the turn and was outrun.
