WON DAY went to the front, drove clear around the turn, pulled away down the lane and proved much the best. TWO JET pressed the pace, made a bid around the turn, couldn't keep up with the winner, but was best of others. DOLLY'S GUITAR lacked early speed, made a late gain, but proved no match for the top two. TIFFANY'S FERRARI raced in the back of the pack, showed late interest, finished wide, but was no real factor. PIP SQUEEK broke poorly, racing in the rear, moved up, but was no threat. MADELYN'S HIT raced within contention and faded. SIENNA BREEZE challenged for the early lead, saved ground around the turn and dropped back. LA. GRAND SLAM lacked early speed, raced outside around the turn and was outrun.
