KING ZOG pressed the early pace, forwardly placed throughout, moved up around the turn, dueled down the lane and drove clear late. SEVERUS SQUALL bumped early, quickly went to the front, drove clear, saved ground around the turn, proved no match late for the winner, but was best of others. KNIGHT'S VALOR bumped early, raced near the back, came around the turn on the outside, made a wide bid and proved no match for the top two. HE'S A REAL OUTFIT broke slow, shut off, raced in the rear in the early going, came around the turn on the outside, showed late interest, but was no real factor. GET THE BOSS pressed the early pace, weakened and was no threat late. LUKE'S HIPPIE showed early speed, saved ground around the turn and faded. SWAMP POP broke out, raced near the middle of the field and faded. SUPER TACO void of early speed and was never close. LEGENDARY DREAM lacked early speed and showed little.
