TWELVE NELSON was away swiftly, opted to stalk the pace four wide, vied with SWEET WINNER through the turn, edged clear that foe in the upper stretch and held firm under steady urging. ESSENTIALLY FAST settled off the pace, split foes in the turn and angled out three wide, picked off one more in the stretch but was held at bay by the winner. SWEET WINNER bumped outer foe at the start, claimed a narrow lead between foes shortly after the start, vied for command with TWELVE NELSON through the turn, flattened out into third down the stretch. PALACE REVOLT pressed the pace from along the inside, took a slight hold at the top of the turn, shifted out four wide in the stretch to make some late improvements. BORZ trailed shortly after the start, passed tired foes. KING OF THE WORLD bumped inner foe at the start, pressed the pace three wide between runners, lacked a response, faded. MENCKE raced off the pace, trailed shortly after the quarter.
