MAXIMUS MAGIC was unhurried early, advanced to the turn, awaited room, bid six wide, got up near the sixteenth pole and drew clear. STYNER pressed the pace to the second turn, assumed command, led past the eighth pole and yielded to finish second best. KERNNESS set a pressured pace to the second turn, dropped back and held for show. BE BETTER raced close to the pace, closed inside, was within range and came up empty late. LAKE CHAPALA moved up outside along the backstretch, advanced to the turn, swung seven wide and tired. WINTER'S GHOST went five wide on the first turn, raced close to the pace, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. MIDNIGHT ONYX was slow early, went eight wide entering the stretch and lacked a response. BOURBON STATE was not a factor. COMMINGLING stalked inside, was through after a half and dropped back steadily.
