GUY'S TRIP chased down the backstretch, took the lead outside MAGIC MIKEY near the three eighths pole and pulled away through the stretch under energetic urging. GUARD OF HONOUR, void of speed, circled horses the far turn, drifted six wide at the head of the stretch and passed tired horses. IT A LEE, shuffled back early, raced wide on the turns and weakened in mid stretch. TALL COTTON stalked outside horses down the backstretch, was well positioned leaving the far turn and gave way near the eighth pole. MIGRATORY, along the inner rail on the backstretch, remained along the rail around the far turn and weakened. BAD BOY BLAZE lacked speed, swung wide in upper stretch and came up empty. FIRST OFFICER broke slowly, was wide around the first turn, offered a mild move on the far turn and gave way. KING OF THE WORLD raced in the three path on the first turn and was not a factor. MAGIC MIKEY set the pace along the inner rail to the far turn and faltered near the three eighths pole.

MISSY MOOSEY stayed in the two path on the turn while stalking the three way pace battle, had ample room inside MISS MO TOWN in the stretch, secured command approaching the sixteenth pole and drove clear. MISS MO TOWN bumped with MAGGIE'S MOON leaving the backstretch, raced inside horses in the three path dueling around the turn drifted to four path turning for home and continued gamely. IT'S NANCYTIME NOW , five deep on the turn disputing the pace, drifted to the seven path in upper stretch and weakened. MAGGIE'S MOON bumped with MISS MO TOWN leaving the backstretch, disputed the pace between horses around the turn, was herded to the five path in upper stretch and weakened. SMOKESHOW was outrun after breaking slowly. MOLLY THE GREAT hugged the inner rail on the turn while stalking the pace battle and gave way.

WORLD BUILDER , three wide the first turn, worked between horses the far turn, moved to the six path approaching the eighth pole, closed strongly outside rivals and was up at the finish. PEGSTER , four deep leaving the backstretch and on the far turn, challenged for the lead outside QUEEN WILHELMINA

approaching the stretch, dueled with that one through the lane and gave way grudgingly. QUEEN WILHELMINA , checked to avoid the heels of MAJOR MAYHEM entering the first turn, bid for the lead three deep on the backstretch, was hooked by PEGSTER on the far turn, battled inside that one and finished willingly. SAUCY SIX , rated along the inner rail down the backstretch, eased off the fence leaving the far turn, swung to the five path in mid stretch and rallied. SAVANASRIOGUERRERA raced between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. MAJOR MAYHEM bore out entering the first turn, was prominent to mid stretch then weakened. GO MISCHIEVOUS was no factor. HYSTERICS raced inside horses in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOMME RIVER , no factor, swung very wide in upper stretch. APPLE SHAKE SHAKE bobbled slightly at the break, circled the first turn four wide and was outrun. BULLE BABE showed speed along the inner rail and weakened in upper stretch. SWEET AND FEISTY , three wide the first turn, faltered on the far turn.

HONOR MAGS , angled in early, remained along the inner rail in a forward position, secured command leaving the far turn then dug in tenaciously in the stretch run. SKI BUM , four deep the first turn, was a forward factor outside horses down the backstretch, circled the far turn three wide, challenged for the lead turning for home and was out finished. ALRASIKH , three wide the first turn, offered a mild, three wide advance leaving the far turn and failed to sustain

then rally. RAGMAN bumped with FUTURE BLUES leaving the starting gate, rated inside horses, was in hand waiting for room leaving the far turn, raced between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. BABBLE , checked in tight quarters after a slow start, circled the far turn four to five deep then leveled off the stretch. SARATOGA CRUISER lacked speed, worked between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. KITTEN'S PLOY , between horses down the backstretch, angled in and raced along the inner rail on the far turn and gave way in mid stretch. DOUBLE MILES , no factor, swung very wide turning for home. I WANNA ROCK stayed along the inner rail on the backstretch and far turn then gave way in the stretch. MACH TWO BLUE , thee wide both turns, dropped back. FUTURE BLUES bumped with RAGMAN leaving the starting gate, stayed along the inner rail stalking the pace and faltered on the far turn.

CURLINS CRUZIN , outside rivals well off the disputed pace, ranged up four wide leaving the turn and passed tired horses. GRANTED SUCCESS disputed the pace between horses and faded in the stretch. ROLLY ,three deep, disputed the pace to mid stretch then weakened. LATIN SPICE , off the duel, came into the turn in the two path and failed to rally. AARAJ hugged the inner rail disputing the pace, steadied in tight quarters near the five sixteenths pole and weakened. MIDNIGHT GETAWAY remained along the inner rail and was no factor.
