LUCKY SIETE bumped with MIDNIGHT RIDE when forced in leaving the starting gate, advanced three deep leaving the turn, challenged for the lead in upper stretch, remained on his left lead and drove clear. MIDNIGHT RIDE bumped with the winner at the start, raced between horses leaving the backstretch, eased out to the four path turning for home, stayed on his left lead and rallied. ROAD CAT stayed along the inner rail on the turn, moved to the two path in upper stretch, split horses in mid stretch and flattened out. JOHNNY G , forced in by SQUARED CIRCLE leaving the starting gate, circled the three three wide, floated to the four path in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. BRISK ALLEY prompted the pace outside the leader and weakened the final furlong. SQUARED CIRCLE bore in leaving the starting gate, hugged the inner rail on the turn and was not a facto. KING XISCO , between horses on the turn, was not a factor. TORTOLE set a pressured pace along the inner rail and weakened in mid stretch. HENRY M , three wide on the turn, was outrun.
