LEO'S FOO sped to the front and went clear on the first turn, remained along the rail, responded to urging in the drive and edged away. PLENTY ON TAP stayed along the inner rail the first turn, swung outside on the backstretch, advanced four deep on the far turn and flattened out. AGENDUM , steadied in traffic the first turn, worked between horses, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied. REBEL PRINCE , steadied in close quarters the first turn, saved ground the far turn, was well placed in upper stretch and weakened. QUAIN , steadied on heels the first turn, was not a threat and passed tired horses. SEVEN'S GOOD broke slowly, raced wide on the far turn and failed to rally. DRIVEN BY MAGIC , four deep the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, raced along the inner rail in the stretch and lacked a rally. HOPEYGOT , reluctant to load into the starting gate, chased the winner and weakened in upper stretch.
