GOOD BYTES lacked speed, raced three wide around the first turn, remained outside horses down the backstretch, circled the far turn floated to the four path in upper stretch, rallied steadily outside horses and was up in deep stretch. BLOND ROAST raced in the two path on both turns and rallied nicely between horses. TIME FOR YOU , angled in early, hugged the inner rail on the turns, eased out to the two path turning for home, gained the lead in mid stretch and faded in the drive. FIRESTREAK saved ground the first turn, raced four to five wide leaving the far turn and passed tried horses. VOLUNTARY stayed outside horses down the backstretch, moved up three wide to take aim on the lead turning for home and gave way the final furlong. REPPAZZ set the pace along the inner rail and weakened in mid stretch. EXTRA SPECIAL hugged the inner rail most of the trip and gave way the far turn. MINISTER CONFESSOR chased the pace and faltered.
