IN THE DANCE settled back to be the distant trailer in the early stages, was cued along the outside of the far turn to take over the lead at the eighth pole and held sway. FROSTY THE GIANT broke alertly to show the way along the inside, continued under pressure from PRETORIAN GOLD up the backstretch, shook that foe off in the far turn before meeting two more challengers in the upper stretch, fought hard but ultimately finished second. ASSUME NOTHING found a tracking position four wide, was roused about the far turn to enter the stretch in a prominent position but was held at bay by the dueling leaders. ESCAPE KEY was forwardly placed between runners, lacked a bid in the final stages. PRETORIAN GOLD pressed the early pace setter in the two path, was asked by the rider in the far turn but lacked a response and retreated. MALIBU MAMBO shadowed the pace just off the rail, began retreating in the far turn.
