PERUGIA , checked on heels leaving the backstretch, raced in the two path between horses on the turn, swung to the four path turning for home, closed outside horses and took the lead in deep stretch. MIGUEL'S BELLE chased three wide around the turn, gained a short lead outside RITABOOK in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly inside the winner. RITABOOK rushed up between horses shortly after the break to take the lead, set the pace in the two path around the turn, was hooked in mid stretch and gave way. AWESOME PIC hugged the inner rail pursuing the pace around the turn then weakened. LILLIPUT , between horses in the stretch drive, passed tired ones. BAHHA SECRET steadied in tight quarters about a sixteenth of a mile after the start, raced wide on the turn, was fanned six wide in upper stretch and failed to be a factor. BELLA PRIMA , a forward factor in the four path entering the turn, gave way.
